



Information on data processing
pursuant to Art. 13 - 14 of GDPR 2016/679
and Legislative Decree No. 101 of 10 August 2018

1. PROCESSING PURPOSE

The processing of personal data is carried out for purposes related to the establishment and carrying out of commercial/contractual relationships with the Company to which you belong, and in particular for:

- a. fulfillment of contractual obligations;
- b. legal obligations related to civil, tax and accounting regulations, as well as deriving from community regulations and provisions
- c. financial and credit purposes, as well as credit control and protection ones;
- d. assumption of pre-contractual information, directly and/or through appointed agencies;
- e. commercial and functional purposes of the Undersigned activity relating to goods/services you usually purchase
- f. promotional activity relating to goods/services offered by the Undersigned, and different from the previous section.

The data processed will be those relating to the Company to which you belong (company name, registered office address, operational headquarters address, VAT number, Tax Code, telephone number, fax number, generic email address, etc.), but also those relating to you (name and surname, direct telephone number, company mobile number, own email, etc.). This information is necessary for the processing of the latter.

2. PROCESSING METHOD

The personal data in question may be processed through paper, IT and telematic tools, with the use of security measures to ensure the confidentiality of the person to whom the data refer and to avoid undue access to third parties or unauthorized personnel. In any case, the processing of your personal data will take place in accordance with the law according to principles of lawfulness and correctness and in order to protect your confidentiality.

3. NATURE OF DATA PROVISION

The provision of data is mandatory for all legal and contractual obligations. Any partial or total refusal to provide the mandatory data will make it impossible to establish or further develop any relationship with you; in the case of optional data, there will be no negative consequences, except for the impossibility of managing the appropriate information in relations between the parties.

4. DATA COMMUNICATION

The personal data relating to the processing in question may be communicated by the Undersigned, solely for reasons related to the above-mentioned purposes, to:

Commercial Agents, Suppliers, Customers, External Deposits and Freight Forwarders, Consultants, Banks and Credit Institutions, Public Administrations, Debt Collection Companies, Commercial Information Companies, Factoring Companies, Insurance Companies, Professional (Legal and Commercial) Firms, Data processing companies, Auditing companies.

5. DATA DISCLOSURE

The personal data processed, in any way, will be brought to the attention of indeterminate subjects.

6. TRANSFER ABROAD

The personal data processed will not be transferred abroad, within or outside the European Union.

7. RIGHTS OF THE DATA SUBJECT

You have the right to:

- propose a complaint to a supervisory authority (Article 13-14 of GDPR 2016/679);
- know which personal data are processed by the Undersigned, their origin, the purpose and method of processing (Article 15 of GDPR 2016/679);
- submit a request for rectification to the Data Controller (Article 16 of GDPR 2016/679);
- submit a request for cancellation (right to be forgotten) of the data managed by the Data Controller (Article 17 of GDPR 2016/679);
- submit a request for processing limitation (Article 18 of GDPR 2016/679);
- submit a request for opposition in cases where the processing falls within what is defined in Art. 21 of GDPR 2016/679.

8. PROCESSING DURATION

The processing will last no longer than necessary for the purposes for which the data were collected.



However, if the Data Subject deems, for any reason, the purpose of the processing to be exhausted, he/she must give written notice to the Data Controller indicated below, who will take action for the immediate cancellation of the information.

9. DATA CONTROLLER

10. DATA PROTECTION MANAGER
